No. 21-55-39.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 4 and 17 of the Indian Arms Act, 1878 (XI of 1878), the Central Government is pleased to direct that the following further amendment shall be made in the Indian Arms Rules, 1924, namely:—

For clause (ii) to rule 4 of the said Rules, the following clause shall be substituted, namely:

"(ii) asphyxiating, poison gas, irritant or other gases and analogous liquids, materials or devices which are not used in any bona fide industrial process in India."
